**Sub: Environmental Clearance in respect of Pappu Valley HEP (48 MW) by M/s Vensar Constructions Company Ltd. in East Kameng District of Arunachal Pradesh.**

Sir,

This has a reference to your letter No. VCCL/200/ 09/2012 dated 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2012 and letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 on the subject mentioned above.

2. The project is proposed to be developed on Built, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT) Basis. The project envisages construction of a 18 m high dam across Pappu River, a tributary of River Kameng near Gangtung Village in East Kameng District of Arunachal Pradesh. The project is run of the river scheme. The total land requirement is 33.62 ha which includes 5.71 ha of underground area. Total submergence area is 5.07 ha. No residential land is getting submerged. A surface powerhouse is proposed on the right bank of the River Pappu near Paling Village with 3 units of 16 MW each. No National Park/ Sanctuary/ Biosphere Reserve/ Historical monument exists in the vicinity of the project area. The total project cost is about Rs. 440.10 crores and will be completed in three and a half years.
3. The above proposal was considered by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2012 for appraisal of EIA Study Report and EMP.
4. The State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Arunachal Pradesh hereby accords Environmental Clearance for the project as per provisions of the Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 subject to strict compliance of the following conditions.
