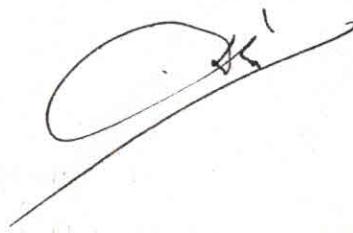

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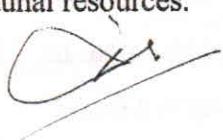
ANNUAL PLAN OF OPERATION FOR COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION, NET PRESENT VALUE, CATCHMENT AREA TREATMENT AND WILDLIFE & BIO-DIVERSITY PROTECTION FOR 2012-13

Introduction

Arunachal Pradesh is strategically located in the extreme North-Eastern part of India having international border on three sides, Bhutan in the West, China and Tibet in the North and North-East, and Myanmar in the East, and nationally with Assam in the South and Nagaland in the South-East. It has a geographical area of 83,743 sq. km., which constitutes 2.54% of the total area of the country, with rugged terrain of deep valleys and high mountains of the Eastern Himalayan Ranges. The wide ranging elevations from about 100 m adjoining Assam plains with Shiwalik Hill Ranges to a great height of 7000 m in the Greater Himalayas with snow capped peaks give rise to wide variations in topography, soil, river systems (Siang, Kameng, Subansiri, Lohit, Tirap, Dibang and their tributaries), climatic conditions with varying temperature, rainfall, humidity and accompanied diverse vegetation with unparalleled bio-diversity of flora and fauna. Of the total geographical area, about 12% is under permanent snow cover and glaciers. Rainfall varies from 1000 mm in the higher reaches to 5750 mm in the foothill areas, spread over 8-9 months except drier days in winter.

Floral and Faunal Diversity

Nature has been exceedingly kind and has endowed this beautiful State with diverse forests and magnificent wildlife. The state is a home of myriad life forms coexisting in diverse ecological situations in their pristine glory. The frontier state is today known for its rich bio-diversity. Floristically, there are more than 5000 species of flowering plants, 600 species of orchids, 89 species of bamboos, 18 species of canes, 400 species of ferns, 24 species of gymnosperms and an equally high number of unexplored algae, fungi, lichens, bryophytes, and micro-organisms inhabiting the state. Thus, this Eastern Himalayan State harbours more than 33% of the total Indian flora with unique taxa and a large number of genetic resources making it a “**Cradle of speciation**” and center of origin of a number of cultivated plants. Faunistically, the state is also rich in having more than 100 species of mammals, 650 birds, 83 reptiles, 130 fishes and 7 non-human primates and innumerable species of insects, micro-organisms and other life forms. Thus, the rich bio-diversity both of flora and fauna have contributed to its recognition as one of the 18 “**Biodiversity Hotspots**” in the world. Such an unparalleled occurrence of life forms can be attributed to the peculiar location of the State which is at the junction of the Paleoarctic, Indo-Chinese, and Indo-Malayan bio-geographic regions. Biotic elements from these regions occur in this State making it very rich in floral and faunal resources.



Forest Resources

Recorded Forest Area

The recorded forest area in the State is 51,540 Sq. Km., which is 61.55% of the geographical area. Per capita forest in the State is estimated to be about 6.00 ha as against national average of 0.10 ha. Reserved Forests, Protected Forests and Unclassed Forests constitute 20.46%, 18.49% and 61.05% of the total forest area respectively. Of the total forest area, 5.138 million ha is State-owned and only 15,500 ha are under private ownership (India's State of Forest Report, 2009).

Protected Areas

There are 2 (two) National Parks and 11 (eleven) Wildlife Sanctuaries in the State covering an area of 2,468.235 Sq. Km. and 7,487.75 Sq. Km. respectively. The protected area constitutes 11.89% of the geographical area of the State. Arunachal Pradesh has two Tiger Reserves (Namdapha and Pakke) covering 2,847.185 Sq. km. In addition, the State has a biosphere reserve named Dihang-Dibang Biosphere Reserve; with an area of 5,112 Sq. km. situated in the higher reaches of West Siang, Upper Siang and Dibang Valley districts of the State.

Forest Cover

The forest cover of the State, based on interpretation of satellite data of Nov, 2006-Jan. 2007, is 67,353 Sq. Km., which is 80.43% of the State's geographical area. In terms of forest canopy density classes, the State has 20,858 Sq. Km. very dense Forests, 31556 Sq. Km. moderately dense forests and 14,939 Sq. Km. open. The district-wise forest cover has been given below:

A. Annual Plan of Operation for Compensatory Afforestation for 2012-13

The basic objective of enacting the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is to keep the forest area of the country intact by compensating the forestland diverted for non-forestry purposes for developmental projects such as industries, roads, railways, mining for exploitation of mineral resources, Hydel projects, multi-purpose projects, laying of transmission lines etc. by way of raising compensatory afforestation plantation over the equivalent area in case of non-forestland and double the area diverted area in case of degraded forest areas. In other words, the Act is the interface between environmental conservation and development by regulating both. The Act as such, is not prohibitory but regulatory in its application. In view of this basic objective, successful raising and maintenance of compensatory afforestation plantation is of outmost importance.

Raising and maintenance and other related activities of the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme are of deposit works which are taken up in the surveyed and demarcated degraded forestland or non-forestland as proposed by the State Govt. and approved by the Central Govt. under the Act and deposited by the User Agencies in compliance to the conditions stipulated in the Approval-in-Principle letter. The activities include pre-planting works like survey & demarcation of CA area, nursery creation & maintenance, creation of CA plantation, fencing, construction and maintenance of OBT/MIB buildings at the plantation site, maintenance of plantation, casualty / vacancy filling, engagement of eligible persons as Afforestation Supervisors, Assistant Afforestation Supervisors, Computer Operators, Drivers, Helpers, Afforestation Watchers for ward and watch of the plantations, purchase and maintenance of vehicles, motorcycles, equipments etc. for supervision and management as per approved provisions.. These items are included in the detailed estimate prepared for creation and maintenance of CA plantations based on the approved cost norms which is submitted to the Central Govt. along with the diversion proposal and is implemented subject to approval and release of fund, now to the State CAMPA by the Adhoc CAMPA in the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, New Delhi as per the Annual Plan of Operation prepared by the Executive Committee and approved by the Steering Committee of the State CAMPA.

A sub component 'entry point activities' have been included in CA component with a view to take care of livelihood of the people who have given their community

land for CA plantations. As per the decision taken by the CAMPA governing body in its third meeting held on 7th august 2012 some eco-development activities/livelihood activities Viz piggery, poultry development, mithun farming etc will be taken up under this component. A provision of 184 lakh has been made in the APO for this purpose. A sub committee under the Chairmanship of CF(S&P) with both the non official members of executive committee, one representative from animal husbandry department, DCF Cons / CAMPA and FAO as members will finalize the modalities/ guidelines for executing the programme.

Till 2010-11, a total area 6748 ha. of Compensatory Afforestation plantations have been raised in the State against 19198 ha of forestlands diverted for various non-forestry purposes. During the 5-year Action Plan period (2010-11 to 2014-15), raising and maintenance of 10,500 ha of CA are envisaged. Out of these, 2047 ha. was raised upto 2011-12. Further, another 2389 ha. is to be raised during 2012-13 for which advance works including pre-planting items such as survey and demarcation of plantation, creation and maintenance of nursery are to be taken up during 2012-13 under different Forest Divisions after approval of the Steering Committee of the State CAMPA.

The state of Arunachal Pradesh has already transferred a sum of Rs. 171.53 crores to CAF account of Arunachal Pradesh maintained by Adhoc CAMPA in MoEF as on 31/08/2012.

B. Annual Plan of Operation for Net Present Value Fund for 2012-13

Status of NPV Fund

The state of Arunachal Pradesh has already transferred a sum of Rs. 285.65 crores to the CAF account of Arunachal Pradesh maintained by Adhoc CAMPA in MoEF as on 31/08/2012. In additional to this, an amount of Rs. 238.72 crores being NPV amount has been deposited by NHPC Ltd. directly with the Registry of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India against the forestland diverted in the State's portion for 2000 MW Subansiri

Lower Hydro Power Project. This amount is stated to be under process of transfer to the State's CAF account maintained by Adhoc-CAMPA at Delhi. Rs. 238.72 crores will be utilized on its transfer to the State's CAF Account maintained by the Adhoc CAMPA and subsequent release to the State CAMPA Account by the Adhoc CAMPA.

Activities:

As per recommendation of the Adhoc-CAMPA, the money realized towards NPV shall be utilized for implementation of the major activities falling in following categories.-

1. Natural Assisted Regeneration.
2. Forest Protection and Management.
3. Wildlife Protection and Management.
4. Infrastructure Development.
5. Supply of wood and other forest product saving devices and other allied activities.
6. Minimum infrastructure for functioning of the State CAMPA (out of interest accrued)
7. Monitoring and Evaluation.

Objectives:

In accordance with the major activities mentioned above, the NPV fund is proposed to be utilized for protection, preservation, conservation and development of natural resources like forests and the wildlife on sustainable basis with the following specific objectives.

- Rehabilitation of jhum lands and encouragement to the communities donating land for compensatory afforestation activities through a scheme of 'Integrated Agro-Horti-Silviculture cultivation' in jhum lands with peoples' participation developed by the Itanagar Regional Centre of G.B. Pant Institute of Himalayan Ecology and Development

- Preservation of threatened and important plant species like *Taxus baccata* through in-situ and ex-situ conservation methods in specific areas like Tawang, West Kameng and West Siang districts (Mechuka area).
- Strengthening of infrastructure for forestry research in the state with special emphasis on State Forest Research Institute (SFRI) with a view to improve forest productivity and for production of orchids, medicinal plants and other non-wood forest produces.
- Strengthening of the department by modernization / infrastructure development and capacity building of forest officials. Emphasis has been given on providing accommodation and mobility to the front line staff with a view to improve their efficiency and affectivity.
- Strengthening of forest vigilance and surveillance institutions for reinforcement of forest protection measures against destruction of forests and smuggling of timber & other forest produces & poaching by improving and expanding the infrastructure for Central Mobile Squads of Western Circle, Central Circle and Eastern Circle and providing infrastructure for creation of an additional Mobile Squad Unit for Southern Circle.
- To improve and extend the protected area network for protection, conservation and development of biodiversity and wildlife rich high value bio-formations by creating community reserves and conservation reserves.
- To promote eco-tourism in National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries and other important places of tourist interest to create awareness about the environment, forests and wildlife among the local community and enhance their livelihood opportunities.
- To generate awareness amongst the local people about judicious use of natural resources and seek their participation in reducing use of fire-wood and other forest produce by using forest produce saving devices in the interest of conservation and preservation of natural resources.
- Documentation of Bio-diversity on a pilot basis by preparation of bio-diversity registers.
- Capacity building of the community and other stakeholders by means of trainings, workshops and exposure visits.
- Publicity and awareness campaign about forests, wildlife, ecology, environment, climate change and other allied issues by means of IEC tools.
- Establishment of High Altitude Arboretum
- Establishment of Eco-Park.

In order to achieve the above objectives for conservation of forests for environmental stability and ecological balance, the action plan for a period of five years i.e. 2010-11 to 2014-15 has been prepared to utilize NPV fund. Care has been taken to prioritize the activities which have the utmost urgency and significance for the State.

Key activities have been identified for this purpose under the following heads.-



NATURAL ASSISTED REGENERATION

Objective: Rehabilitation of jhumed (Shifting cultivation) areas which is the main agriculture practice of the local people in most parts of the State. With the increasing population, changing life style of the people and changing land-use pattern, jhum cycle of shifting cultivation has come down resulting in land degradation. This scheme aims at the socio-economic upliftment of the local people living in the areas around the CA plantation as incentive for donating the land for CA by rehabilitating the jhumed areas and improving the land-use pattern through the integrated Agro-Horti-Forestry plantation. It includes planting fruit trees along with timber tree species in addition to developing the flat and gentle slope portion for terrace cultivation in the abandoned jhumed lands with people's participation and 83.33% of Rs. 1.5 lakh as assistance with limit of 1.00 Ha per household. Creating aided natural regeneration in notified forests aims at enriching the poorly stocked forests. Encouraging raising of fuelwood plantation by the local people to augment the fuelwood requirement so as to minimize destruction of natural forests for fuel wood.

(i) Integrated Agro-Horti-Silvicultural Cultivation:

Jhum / Shifting cultivation (Slash and burn cultivation) is an age old system of agriculture among the indigenous tribes of Arunachal Pradesh. The entire gamut of their socio-cultural life is woven around jhuming that is not only an agricultural activity but a cultural practice and a way of life. It is viewed as an exploitative system, wherein the land and natural resources are not managed optimally and is taken to be a major cause of deforestation and ecological instability. As per statistics of the agriculture department, about 1.10 lakh hectare area is under jhum / shifting cultivation and nearly 54,000 families are reportedly dependent on it for their livelihood and sustenance. Shortening of jhum cycle has led to decline in the productivity and hence the conditions of land degradation.

In order to wean away the jhumias from the age old and destructive method of shifting cultivation, an integrated 'Agro-Horti-Silviculture cultivation' model developed by the North-Eastern Regional Center of G.B. Pant Institute of Himalayan Ecology and Development for jhum lands is proposed to be implemented as a pilot project. The model envisages to plant at least 200 seedlings of tree species and 200 seedlings of fruit plant species at a spacing of 4-5m x 4-5m per hectare besides shifting agriculture crops, cereals, pulses, vegetables and paddy and fish culture.

This scheme shall be taken up as a pilot project on experimental basis to encourage the local jhumias to stabilize the jhuming/ rehabilitate the abandoned jhum areas and also to create more avenues for uplifting the economy of the local people, besides increasing tree cover. This scheme shall be reviewed in due course considering the response / acceptance of the local people after gaining more experience on the subject matter.

The guidelines for payment of assistance and execution of the items of work will be formulated and communicated to the implementing agencies in due course.

(ii) Fuelwood Plantation:

In high altitude areas of Arunachal Pradesh, the consumption of fuel wood is very high. It is used for heating of offices, residential buildings, heating water in the urban areas and small towns and even for cooking in rural areas. The fuel wood so required is collected from the forests. Thus, the collection of fuel wood from the forests leads to deforestation and denudation. Therefore, a scheme of fuel wood plantation has been envisaged under NPV fund in order to augment supply of fuel wood from the sources outside forest for domestic use. Under the scheme, it is conceived to raise fuel wood plantations in the village community land as well as private land in the vicinity of the village. Financial assistance for creation and maintenance of plantations up to 3 years is proposed.

(iii) Bamboo and Cane Plantation:

Bamboo and cane plantations will be taken up in the UF/VRF/ARF areas which are covered under working schemes and plantations could not be taken up due to paucity of funds from state plan funds.

(iv) Avenue and Block Plantations: Avenue and Block Plantations will be taken up along the roads vacant lands in school and other complexes to enhance the tree cover in the areas outside the forest areas.

Target for Natural Assisted Regeneration during 2012-13:

During this year, 20 ha. of Agro-Horti-Silviculture cultivation, 130 ha. of fuelwood plantation, 70 ha. medicinal plantation, 134 ha. bamboo plantation besides avenue plantations at an outlay of Rs. 126.44 lakhs.

Forest Protection and Management

(i) Forest Protection

Objective:- Forests are considered as an open resource and open treasure and are exposed to illegal exploitation, fires, encroachments, poaching and other unlawful activities. Out of the 80.43% Forest cover, 51,540.00 Sq.Km. is recorded as forests comprising of RF, PF, ARF, VRF, Wildlife Sanctuaries, National Parks, Elephant Reserve, Tiger Project/Reserve, Biosphere Reserve and Unclassed State Forests. This vast expanse of forests of Arunachal Pradesh with treacherous terrains, numerous rivers and streams and inaccessible areas are to be protected. Further the lands made available to the department in the towns and habitations outside the notified forest areas for developing the forest establishments and creation of forest assets like nurseries, sample/research plots and complexes, forest parks etc are under threat of encroachment due to rapid urbanization of the areas. Therefore it is necessary that a better communication network is established with fast moving ability of the protection squads armed with

weapons and legal back-up and forest assets in encroachment prone areas are protected through security fencing/walls. This also needs to be backed up by a proper extension strategy to create awareness amongst the people to preserve and conserve the forests. Arunachal Pradesh has, perhaps, the lowest deployment of staff per unit area of forest which further aggravates the problem of forest protection. Attempts have been made to remove these bottlenecks with the funds available under NPV funds.

(a) Strengthening of Central Mobile Squad at Forest Circle Level:

In addition to existing three Central Mobile Squad Units headed by an ACF viz: Central Mobile Squad for Western Arunachal Circle, Central Mobile Squad for Central Arunachal Circle and Central Mobile Squad for Eastern Arunachal Circle, it is proposed to create a Central Mobile Squad Unit for Southern Arunachal Circle within the existing sanctioned posts of ACF / FR / Dy. FR/Fr. /Fgd. The infrastructure is proposed to be provided to the new mobile squad from the NPV fund. Strengthening of mobile squad is also envisaged to improve its efficiency and effectiveness. It is proposed to provide accommodation, mobility, arms & ammunition, communication facilities and accommodation etc to the mobile squads.

(b) Strengthening of Forest Protection at Divisional Level.

To supplement the efforts of the Central Mobile Squad at the circle level and to have the regular patrolling in the divisions, especially in the divisions having illegality prone forest areas along inter state borders the divisional forest protection squads are being established with the help of existing staff and following activities will be taken

- i. Providing light motor vehicles for the ranges
- ii. Constitution of division level patrolling squads for forest divisions having interstate border as well as other divisions with ACF/RO attached to divn/RO central check gate, one Dy FR/ forester and two forest guard as members. Squad will be assisted by 6-8 casual workers engaged for maximum 20 days in a month.

(c) Forest Fire Prevention Plan;

The forest areas , particularly the areas close to townships and nearby jhum areas, are prone to forest fire during the winter months because of jhum burning. To control the forest fires following activities will be taken

- i. Patrolling of forest areas around district /divisional HQs by Village Forest Fire Prevention Team(VFFPT) comprising of villagers from the villages around the HQs for 5 fire prone winter months from November to March.
- ii. Fire line cutting subject to maximum 3 Km
- iii. Awareness through audio visual and print media.

(d) Strengthening of Check Gates:

All the forest check gates are to be strengthened. Sufficient staff will be provided to the gates for round the clock duty in shift basis and provisions will be made to be made for accommodation of the staff at the check gate or nearby areas.

(b) Reward to Informers:

The deployment of frontline staff per unit area of the forest in Arunachal Pradesh is the lowest in the country due to vast area of 80.43% under forest cover. Hence, a network of intelligence is required to be established for gathering information on forest

offences and crimes. It is proposed to gather information from public by keeping the

provisions for rewarding them for which the fund is placed at the disposal of territorial

CCFs. The purpose of primary intelligence network in the forest areas that are vulnerable

to illegal activities and giving reward to the primary informers on illegalities in forest is

envisioned in the Action Plan as well as APO. Amount of reward to be decided at the

appropriate level. Continuation of the component will be subject to success of the

Objective:- In Arunachal Pradesh, there are 89 nos. notified Reserved Forests including

Anchal Reserved Forests and Village Reserved Forests covering an area of 10374.95

Sq.Km. Most of these notified forests are covered under Working Plan subject to

revision. Effort is on to cover the remaining notified forest also under the Working Plan for scientific management. Efforts are on to bring the USF areas under the Working Schemes for scientific management. Providing basic infrastructure to the Resources Survey & Working Plan Circle / Divisions for surveying for preparation of Working Plans / Schemes is envisaged in the APO.

Strategy: An agreement has been signed with North Eastern Space Application Centre (NESAC), Shillong for preparing E working plans/schemes using remote sensing and GIS technology. Six divisions have been selected for survey as per new RS/and GIS based methodology for preparing the Working plans of RF areas and working schemes for USF/community forests. Survey of the Along forest division as per new RS/and GIS based methodology is already in progress

(b) Human Resource Development

(i) Strengthening of Arunachal Pradesh Forest Training Institute (APFTI):

For proper and scientific management of our forest and wildlife resources, there is need of well-trained manpower. Constant up-gradation of skills and technical knowledge are also needed to implement the latest technology in forestry. Forest officers of Forest Ranger level and above are trained at National level institutes while the frontline staffs are being trained at Arunachal Pradesh Forest Training Institute, Roing.

The Arunachal Pradesh Forest Training Institute imparts training to Foresters and Forest Guards with a view to develop professional and technical knowledge about forestry and it's allied subjects. The number of trainees in the institute has increased considerably and female officials are also being recruited. The curriculum and issues related to the subject have expanded considerably. It is not possible to cope up with the requirement of training of forest executive staff within the available infrastructure. The residential and office buildings need renovation/improvement and new buildings need to be built, hostel need up-gradation and hostel for female staff is required to be built. Modern teaching gadgets and equipments, modern nursery, mist chamber, green house etc are essential to provide modern technology education. The following items of work are proposed. In addition to running regular training courses of Foresters and Forest Guards, the conducting refresher courses for Forest Rangers & Dy. Forest Rangers is also envisaged.

(ii) Capacity building:

In order to improve the man-power resources and its utilization, mainly for preservation of flora and fauna and economic resources utilization, it is felt necessary to conduct workshop, training and seminar in the State involving the local people at State, Forest Circle, Division & Range level. It is proposed to conduct workshop, training and seminar to educate the field officials and local people about the forestry activities including preservation of environment & biodiversity and its importance in day to day

life. Excursion and visit to relevant activity sites for the participating villagers and implementing / involving officials and attending relevant workshop / seminar and visit to relevant sites within the country and overseas for the officials involved in planning and designing the programmes are envisaged.

(1) **Trainings / Workshops:** Conducting and attending training programmes/workshops on various aspects of environment, forests and wildlife conservation, ecological balance, climate change, global warming etc. for the departmental officers & staff at divisional, state, interstate and international levels is envisaged.

(2) **Exposure visits :-** Supporting exposure visits for participating villagers within the state and neighbouring states and departmental officers & staff to the places of environmental and forestry importance within/outside the state and overseas is emphasized.

(c) Information, Education and Communication (IEC):

The people living in rural areas in and around the forests depend on forests for their day-to-day livelihood. Meaningful participation of these people will help not only in solving their problems but will also help in preservation and protection of forests. The support of people in protecting forests and promoting forest conservation is critical as a long-term management strategy. As such, it is proposed to launch massive awareness programme amongst the local people of the State through information, education and communication methods in the form of publication materials such as pamphlets, brochures, posters & banners, mass media such as wall paintings, hoardings, sign boards radio/tv programmes/talks, folk media such as street plays, nukkad natak & puppet shows and LCD & audio-visual aides. Also by observing forest festivals like Vanamohotsava, Wildlife Week, Earth's day, Ozone day etc. and ceremonial plantation on national days, local festivals etc. at the Department Head/Circle/Division/Range level.

Use of services of appropriate Media Agencies as consultant for IEC strategy including designing the programmes for implementing this activity is envisaged.

(d) Arunachal Pradesh Environment Awareness Campaign(APEAC):

Arunachal Pradesh Environment Awareness Campaign (APEAC)2012-13 is also being launched in the line of National Environment Awareness Campaign (NEAC). The guidelines for APEAC are based on the guidelines of NEAC with some modification state specific. Campaign will be taken up at division level and concerned CCF will be regulatory authority for the Campaign.

(e) Research and Extension

(i) Strengthening of the State Forest Research Institute (SFRI):

The State Govt. has established State Forest Research Institute at Itanagar with five Field Stations and seven Research Ranges to conduct research and provide technical support for better forest management. To improve the productivity of forests, the prerequisite is good quality seeds and planting stock. Seed orchards and modern biotechnological techniques such as tissue culture are essential for mass propagation of quality planting materials. Therefore, expansion, improvement and infrastructure development of the existing SFRI, Forestry Research Ranges, Field Stations, VVK at Chessa and ORDC at Tipi as below are emphasized:-

- a) Renovation of SFRI office complex
- b) Improvement of Orchidarium
- c) Study of regeneration behavior commercially viable rain forest species(hollong)
- d) Renovation and up-gradation of SFRI laboratories
- e) Establishment of Thematic garden for ex-situ conservation of rare species likely to be submerged in lower Subansiri HEP
- f) Renovation of Research Nurseries & Green Houses
- g) Digitization of APF herbarium
- h) Ethno botanical studies
- i) Renovation of Zoology labs and musiums
- j) Research & Development on Orchids
- k) Infrastructure development of ORDC, Tipi
- l) Improvement of Sessa Orchid Sanctuary
- m) Preparation of Biodiversity Register for documenting genetic diversity and associated traditional knowledge (Pilot Project)
- n) Growth data Analysis of important tree species for the purpose of working plan preparation

Target for Forest Protection & Management during 2012-13

Construction of check gate – 13 nos., Wages 7 nos., M/Cycle- 11 nos., telephone network connection, research and extension, awareness programme through NGOs, Maint. of vehicles & POL, Procurement of Arms & Ammunition, Reward to informers, Strengthening of APFTI, Training & Workshops, Exposure visits, Publicity & Publication materials, Strengthening of SFRI etc. at an outlay of Rs. 1091.115 lacs is proposed for 2012-13 besides infrastructure development for Protection Force at an outlay of Rs. 300.00 lakhs and strengthening of GIS cell at an outlay of Rs. 100.00 lakhs.

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Objective: The present infrastructure available at field level and Head-Quarters so far developed from the State resources is in-adequate. Against the sanctioned strength of

88 nos. of Executive Officers, 1713 nos. Field Executive Officers & Staff and 820 nos. of Scientists and Ministerial Staff, there are only 1344 nos. of residential buildings. As a result of which, it is very difficult to provide accommodation to field officers / staff and senior level Forest Officers at the Head-Quarters. The infrastructures so far available were constructed many years back which require renovation and at least improvement. In some cases, the life span of buildings is already over and requires dismantling and reconstruction. Most of the 304 nos. of office buildings in the State are also very old and require improvement, renovation and in some cases dismantling and reconstruction. As such, it is necessary to develop infrastructure by constructing residential and non-residential buildings, improving/renovating existing buildings/forest roads/log bridges etc to provide minimum accommodation facilities to Officers and Staff and improve communication for developmental and protection activities of officers/staff.

The existing vehicles of the Department are in-sufficient for carrying out the day to day developmental works, proper supervision of such works in the field and for forest and wildlife protection activities. At present there are 124 vehicles inclusive of LMV/MMV/HMV in the department, out of which only 24 Nos. are off road and to be condemned. Out of the remaining 100 Nos. less than half are in good condition. Therefore, the vehicles which are off road and in bad condition are to be condemned need replacement by new ones. So far the Department has not provided any vehicle to the Range Level Officers and motorcycle to the Beat Level Officers unlike in other states for execution / supervision of developmental works, protection of open forest resources and wildlife. To achieve these objectives, the following activities are proposed in the APO for 2012-13.

- a) Construction of Residential Buildings.
- b) Construction of non-residential buildings including Head Office, Circle Office, Division Office, Range Office, Beat Office and FRH.
- c) Renovation/Improvement of existing residential and non-residential buildings
- d) Improvement/maintenance of Forest Roads in the border areas for protection activities.
- e) Improvement of Log Bridge/Culvert
- f) Procurement and replacement of vehicles and motor cycles
- g) Payment of wages/TE of Drivers/Helpers
- h) Upkeepment and POL of vehicles/motor cycles
- i) Equipments, stores, stationeries, survey & drawing instruments etc.
- j) Computers, laptop and accessories including printers
- k) Photocopiers, fax machines, scanners etc.

Target for Infrastructure Development during 2011-12:

Construction of Residential buildings – 53 Nos., Non-residential buildings – 21 Nos., construction of Security wall/ retaining wall, water supply, garage 3 nos., Renovation of Residential buildings, Non-residential buildings, Improvement of Forest road, Maintenance & POL of vehicles & motor cycles, Wages of drivers/helpers, purchase of Office equipments & stores etc. at an outlay of Rs. 1254.575 lakhs.

WILDLIFE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT.

Objective:- Fanatically, the state is very rich in wild life resources having more than 213 mammal species, 800 bird species, 113 reptile species, 130 fish species, 7 primate and innumerable species of insects, micro-organisms and other live forms. The rich biodiversity in both flora and fauna has contributed to its recognition as one of the Biodiversity Hot Spots in the world. In view of richness of flora and fauna and for its scientific management, development, protection and preservation, the State Govt. has notified and brought under protected net-work for protection, conservation and development of Wildlife and Bio-diversity resources. Moreover, there is a Biological Park which is required to bring upto the requisite standard including security measures. In order to protect these Wildlife Sanctuaries, National Parks and Tiger Reserves, the existing infrastructure, including buildings, vehicles, communication etc. are very much inadequate. It is therefore, proposed to develop the infrastructure by constructing / renovation of residential and non-residential buildings, security walls, demarcation of Protected Areas boundaries with RCC pillars and providing vehicles, motorcycles and communication system to the Field Officers and staff for their effective performance.

Further, 37% of total geographical areas are the community forests, which is called Unclassed State Forests. These community forest areas are outside Reserved Forests and Protected Areas and some forest areas are recognized as sacred groves nearby the Gompas and religious places. There are 8 major Gompas, 108 nos. Wet land (i.e. lakes) and sacred groves maintained by the community in Tawang District. These community forest areas and sacred groves are very rich in flora & fauna and are required to be conserved with community participation. The activities for wildlife and biodiversity conservation during 2012-13 include the followings:

- a) Conservation of wildlife rich Community Forests
- b) Providing communication facilities for Protected Areas including mobile phone etc.
- c) Procurement of vehicles and motor cycles for Officers of Wildlife & Biodiversity Circle
- d) Payment of wages/TE of Drivers
- e) POL & maintenance of vehicles and motor cycles.
- f) Procurement of Speed Boat for 'D' Ering Wildlife Sanctuary
- g) Awareness campaign for wildlife and biodiversity conservation.
- h) Providing fund for reward to informers

Target for Wildlife Protection & Management during 2012-13:

Conservation of wildlife rich Community Forests, Awareness campaign, Construction of residential bldgs. – 8 nos., Non-residential- 01 no, Const. Of security wall, wages, renovation of residential & non-residential bldgs., Reward to informers etc, at an outlay of Rs. 376.967 lakhs.

SUPPLY OF WOOD AND OTHER FOREST PRODUCT SAVING DEVICES AND OTHER ALLIED ACTIVITIES

- (i) Introduction of Pine Briquettes Technology in the State particularly in the areas of the state with pine forests as an alternative to fuelwood
- (ii) Providing Pine Briquette Mould Machines and Stoves
- (iii) Providing Solar Lanterns

Target for Supply of Forest Product Saving Devices during 2012-13:

Purchase of solar cooker at an outlay of Rs.3.60 lakhs

MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF STATE CAMPA PROGRAMMES

An amount of Rs **50.00** lakhs is being kept for concurrent Monitoring & Evaluation of the State CAMPA programmes by the Internal Agency constituted for the purpose and by the External Agency during 2012-13 as per the CAMPA guidelines besides contingency expenditure.

MINIMUM INFRASTRUCTURE FOR FUNCTIONING OF STATE CAMPA

- (i) Manpower:
 - (a) Placement of regular Forest Ranger, Draughtsman, P.I, Accountant / UDC and LDC by the Department.
 - (b) Engagement of minimum retired officials with experience in the subject-matter as contractual supervisors, data entry operator, computer operators, drivers and office peons by the Executive Committee of the State CAMPA as per approved APO.
- (ii). Purchase of staff car and motorcycle.
- (iii) Wages & Salary of Drivers, Peons, Chowkidar, Technical Supervisor, Ministerial support staff including Supervisors, Technical Assistant, Office Clerk, Electrician etc. for State CAMPA Office.
- (iv) P.O.L & upkeepment of vehicles/motorcycle
- (v) Workshops, trainings and meetings i/c TA/DA
- (vi) Equipments including computer & accessories, furniture, stores and stationeries, Office Expenses including honorarium for deserving staff etc.
- (vii) Minor maintenance works of State CAMPA office & residential building

Financial outlay for 2012-13 **Rs. 170.00** lakhs out of the interest accrued on the deposit in the bank.

C. APO FOR CATCHMENT AREA TREATMENT PLAN DURING 2012-13

Objective: As per condition (ii) stipulated in the Environmental Clearance and condition (xiv) of Forest Clearance issued by Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests in respect of 2000 MW Subansiri Lower Hydro Electric Project, the catchment area (1663 ha.) identified for treatment under two Forest Divisions viz- Hapoli & Daporijo is to be treated at the project cost in three years. The approved cost for CAT amounting to Rs. 817.27 lacs has been received from the User Agency i.e NHPC Ltd. which has been transferred to the Adhoc CAMPA, MoEF, New Delhi as per the direction of Govt. of India, MoEF. The approved CAT plan will be implemented by the concerned

Implementing Agencies on receipt of fund from Adhoc CAMPA by the State CAMPA. During the financial year 2012-13, an outlay of Rs. 200.600 lakhs has been proposed which includes Rs. 85.02 lakh spill over work last year.

The Action Plan for CAT may be revised on receipt of estimates from the Divisions and revised fund from the User Agency or as per change if any, in the policy of National CAMPA Advisory Council.

D. ANNUAL PLAN OF OPERATION FOR PROTECTION & PRESERVATION OF WILDLIFE AND BIODIVERSITY AROUND THE 600 MW KAMENG HYDRO ELECTRIC PROJECT FOR 2012-13

Objective: In order to balance the economic development and environmental conservation, the Central Govt. while according the forest clearance for diversion of 710 ha of forestland under section - 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of 600 MW Kameng Hydro Electric Project by NEEPCO Ltd., stipulated a number of conditions. As per condition (v), necessary measures for protection and preservation of wildlife and biodiversity around the project are to be taken by the State Environment & Forests Department at the project cost. Accordingly, the department in consultation with the Project Authorities prepared the Action Plan for an amount of Rs. 347.57 lakhs for the purpose and submitted to the Project Authority after duly approved by the competent authority of the State Govt. The concerned User Agency i.e NEEPCO Ltd. has deposited the amount and the same has been transferred to the National Adhoc CAMPA, MoEF, New Delhi as per the Ministry's direction. A part of the Action Plan with outlay of Rs. 198.98 lakhs will be implemented during 2010-11 to 2014-15 and the remaining during the next 5 years period (2015-16 to 2019-20) by the concerned Implementing Agencies {Divisions/ PCCF(WL&BD)}. Out of 198.98 lakhs, an outlay of Rs. 39.28 lakhs has been proposed in the APO -2012-13 which includes spill over work of Rs. 10.34 lakhs. The works will be implemented through the concerned Implementing Agency.
